A MESSAGE FROM

Supervisor Colarusso and Councilwoman Nan Ackerman:

The Town of Orchard Park is providing this guide containing useful and important information about recycling and refuse pickup. The "Blue Bin" recycling container is provided free to each newly built home and can be purchased for any household in Orchard Park. It is to be used exclusively for storage and collection of post-consumer materials currently accepted in the town-wide curbside recycling program. There is no limit to the amount of "acceptable" material collected weekly. Please consult and follow the guideline contained in this publication to insure the success of our program. Future changes and updates will be posted on this website with links to the current service provider's website. Please remember that the "Blue Bin" should remain in the home if you move. Replacement bins are available at the Municipal Center in the Tax Receiver's Office during regular business hours and are currently priced at \$7.50 per bin.

Remember that increased recycling participation will contribute in the long run to stable refuse disposal costs.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: WHAT HOLIDAYS AFFECT MY SERVICE?

A: Service will be affected by New Years Day, Independence Day, Labor Day Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Q: WHAT DAY WILL I BE SERVICED ON A HOLIDAY WEEK?

A: If one of these holidays falls on or before your scheduled day, service will be (1) day late.

Q: HOW DO I DISPOSE OF COMPUTERS, PROPANE TANKS, HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE, ETC.?

Q: WHERE DO I GET A RECYCLING BIN?

A: Contact the Town of Orchard Park's Tax Receivers Office at 662-6406

Q: WHEN IS BULK AND LARGE TRASH COLLECTED?

A: See Schedule below.

Q: IS THERE A WEEKLY PICKUP LIMIT FOR TRASH?

A: You are allowed 8 bags or cans or the combination of both each week, **exclusive of recycling.**

Q: HOW DO I DISPOSE OF LEAVES?:

A: Loose leaf waste at curb is encouraged by the town for recycling at the Compost center and is picked up seasonally on a regular basis by the Town.

Q: HOW DO I DISPOSE OF CHRISTMAS TREES?

A: Christmas trees are collected by the town the same way that brush is collected.

Residents interested in renting a dumpster For remodeling, roofing or clean up can call Modern at 800-662-0012.

Scrap tires are collected privately by calling Modern Tire Recycling at 800-662-0012.

Rubber mulch for playgrounds and landscape Applications are available from Modern Recycling at 800-662-0012.
