- B. Applications or appeal to the Architectural Overlay Districts Committee, Conservation Board, Conservation Management Overlay District, Planning Board, Town Board and Zoning Board of Appeals shall be subject to the following fees:
 - 1) Initial applications to the architectural Overlay District Committee, Conservation Board, Conservation Management Overlay District, and Planning Board, shall be accompanied by a fee of \$50 payable to the Town of Orchard Park.
 - 2) Zoning Board of Appeals application or appeal, applications for variances or appeals shall be accompanied by a fee of \$100 payable to the Town of Orchard Park. Furthermore, if a petitioner requests adjournment of a public hearing which has been published and noticed, said petitioner shall bear the costs incurred to re-publish or re-notice said hearing.
 - 3) Applications for public hearings before the Town Board or the Planning Board shall be accompanied by a fee of \$100 payable to the Town of Orchard Park.
 - 4) All above fees in this section shall be considered non refundable.

SECTION 2: § Effective Date

This local law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State or from the date of its service as against a person served personally with a copy thereof.

4) THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED BY SUPERVISOR KEEM, WHO MOVED ITS ADOPTION, SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER SHERRY, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, following due and timely notice to a Public Hearing relating to the Matter of Local Law #2 of 2015 regarding "Snow Removal Prohibitions" was conducted on the, March 4th day of March 2015, at which time all interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board is hereby authorized to adopt Local Law #2 for the Year 2015 which provides as follows:

Amend Chapter 120 "Streets and Sidewalks", Article 1 "Landscaping of Rights-of-Way", Section 120-5.1 "Snow Removal Prohibitions"

Amending the above captioned Section 120-5.1 "Snow Removal Prohibitions" as follows:

SECTION 1:

- A. No person or the employer or agent of such person shall actively himself or herself or passively allow someone else to plow, shovel, sweep, snow-blow or pile snow, ice or other such materials into the paved portion of any street or public highway or into the paved portion of the right of way of any street or public highway or sidewalk or onto another private property without consent or cause such to be done so as to interfere with the safety and convenience of public travel or such as to constitute an obstruction of the sight of persons traveling by vehicle or by foot on public streets or sidewalks or on private property.
- B. No person or the employer or agent of such person shall actively himself or herself or passively allow someone else to plow, shovel, snow-blow or pile snow from a private or public driveway in such a manner as to deposit the same in the public roadway or on a public sidewalk.

C. Enforcement:

- 1) Any Infraction by a person, firm or corporation of any provision of this section shall be deemed an offense punishable by a fine not to exceed \$250 or imprisonment for a period not to exceed 15 days, or both.
- 2) Any person who takes part in or assists in any violation of this section shall be subject to the penalties provided herein.
- 3) This section shall be enforced by the members of the Town of Orchard Park Police Department and Code Enforcement Officers.

SECTION 2: § Effective Date

This local law shall take effect upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State or from the date of its service as against a person served personally with a copy thereof.

The resolution was unanimously adopted.

New Business #3 Agreement for Park Pond/Lake Maintenance.

7) THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED BY COUNCILMEMBER SHERRY WHO MOVED ITS ADOPTION, SECONDED BY SUPERVISOR KEEM, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, the Town solicited services and received a proposal from a local environmental consultant firm AquaTech Environmental, Inc., which is qualified and capable to complete lake management work for Green Lake, Pleasant Acres Pond and also the stocking of various Town owned lakes/ponds in the necessary time frame, and

WHEREAS, the environmental services to be provided for the maintenance of Green Lake are proposed as an annual lake maintenance service agreement and will include: NYSDEC Permit Procurement (Currently \$300.00), Aquatic Macrophyte Herbicide Treatment, Algae Herbicide Treatment, Aeration Assessment and Adjustment, and Consultation Services. Aqua Tech Environmental, Inc. lump sum cost to provide the above mentioned treatments for 2015 is \$4,600.00 and

WHEREAS, the services proposed for Birdsong Subdivision Retention Lake are again being discontinued this year, due to the Homeowners Associations refusal to pay 50% of treatment and permitting costs, and

WHEREAS, the Pleasant Acres Retention Ponds all being included in the agreement once again this year for treatment. The developer of the subdivision decided it would be a good option to have in place, if the ponds need treatment. He has agreed to pay for 50% of the permitting fee and the same if treatment is needed. The permitting process (\$300.00) will not be completed at this time, if needed the permit can be applied for and obtained in a few weeks. The services and costs will be in the contract once again, with zero quantities, so if treatment is warranted it can still be completed as a per treatment basis. The treatments will be Filamentous Algae treatments for \$975.00/each and \$1,450.00/each for rooted plants treatment. The total anticipated cost for 2015 is \$0.00 for the year, and

WHEREAS, the continuation of the Town of Orchard Park fish Stocking program recommendations are continuing the baitfish stocking (fathead minnows & golden shiners), game fish stocking (largemouth bass) and grass carp stocking to aid in weed and insect control. The 2015 proposed stocking cost is \$1,997.55, and

WHEREAS, the entire projected cost for Town Lake and Pond maintenance, treatment and stocking for calendar year 2015, is not to exceed \$9,322.55. There are presently funds (\$10,000.00) under Orchard Park Engineering Department "Water Quality Consultants" A.1440.000.448 for this work,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby authorize the Supervisor to sign the application for NYSDEC permit to use a pesticide for the control of aquatic pest for Green Lake Aquatic Vegetation and Algae Control and any other Town Ponds/Lake that requires treatment:

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby authorize Supervisor Keem to sign an agreement with AquaTech Environmental, Inc., 45 Kent Avenue, Blasdell, New York 14219, for an amount not to exceed \$9,322.55 to provide the following as recommended by the Town Engineer;

- Annual environmental services for Green Lake Maintenance in an amount of \$4,600.00 annually for Algae and Weed Treatments.
- Environmental permitting and treatment services for various Town Ponds / Lake; including Pleasant Acres Retention Pond Maintenance.
- Stock fish to specified Town-Owned ponds as per attachment 3.0 & 3.1 Fishery Management Agreement.

The resolution was unanimously adopted.

New Business #4 to Participate in Western New York Storm Water Coalition.

WHEREAS, The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation is making available Environmental Protection Funds. The Water Quality Improvement Projects program provides reimbursement for eligible portion of the cost of implementing projects that include Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) Phase II Stormwater Implementation, and

WHEREAS, funds are intended to assist existing MS4's with newly designated Urbanized Areas with expanding the geographic area of their Storm Water Management Program, and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will result in mapping storm water outfalls, conducting an outfall reconnaissance inventory and mapping the system not previously mapped. The project will also, perform other related work that is needed to comply with the storm water permit GP-0-10-002, and

WHEREAS, Erie County Department of Environment and Planning will oversee the administration of the grant for the Western New York Storm Water Coalition members that participate, and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor is to sign the commitment letter to participate in the Western New York Storm Water Coalition: Newly Designated Urbanized Area Project. The primary focus of the project, is to map storm sewer outfalls and conveyance systems including: catch basin and manhole locations; number and size of connections (inlets/outlets); direction of flow; and delineation of storm sewer sheds in Newly Designated Urbanized Areas. With the required matching contributions being in-kind services by the Orchard Park Engineering Department personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, Town Board does hereby authorize the Supervisor to sign a commitment letter to participate in Western New York Storm Water Coalition project to map newly designated urbanized areas.

12) THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED BY SUPERVISOR KEEM, WHO MOVED ITS ADOPTION, SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER SHERRY, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6-c of the General Municipal Law, the Town Board of the Town of Orchard Park (the "Town") established a Building Reserve - Capital Reserve Fund ("Reserve Fund") to finance the cost of construction, reconstruction and/or acquisition of buildings; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution is subject to a permissive referendum, pursuant to General Municipal Law §6-c, and shall not be effective unless either no petition requesting a referendum meeting the requirements of Town Law §90 is filed within thirty (30) days from the date of this resolution, or this Resolution is approved by the affirmative vote of majority of the qualified electors of the Town of Orchard Park voting on approval of the Resolution; and it is

RESOLVED, that pursuant to §90 of the Town Law that within ten (10) days from the date of this resolution the Town Clerk shall post and publish a notice which shall set forth the date of adoption of the resolution, shall contain an abstract of such resolution concisely setting forth the purpose and effect thereof, shall specify that this resolution was accepted to a permissive referendum; and shall publish such notice in the official newspaper of the Town of Orchard Park, and that in addition thereto that the Town Clerk shall post on the sign board of the Town of Orchard Park, a copy of such notice within ten (10) days after the date of the adoption of this resolution.

BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

ELECTED OFFICIALS & DEPARTMENT HEADS

Supervisor Keem spoke of the 5 hr. Emergency Management Class he attended and said it was very worth while. He was glad he attended the meeting last year, and glad he got to put it to use, and the class this year was even more meaningful

Highway Superintendent Piasecki mentioned that his crews are focused on opening up drainage in subdivisions. As President of the Town Highway Association attended a CHiPs meeting in Albany and the state received a windfall of funding from bank settlements, and expecting Orchard Park to get some funding for town roads, bridges and culverts.
