#### A Note from Jackie Briggs, Community Activity Council of Orchard Park, Inc. President

For those of you who may not be familiar with the Community Activity Council I'd like to share a bit of our history ...

We originated as the Senior Council 15+ years ago. In 2012, the Senior Council decided to begin fundraising to raise money for a new senior center.
