WHEREAS, the Town Board has met and considered the preliminary budget for the year ending December 31, 2021, and a public meeting was conducted on November 4, 2020 as required by Section 108 of Town Law, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to amend the preliminary Ad Valorem budget and the preliminary benefit basis budget to include a two percent wage increase to non-union employees, including department managers and other board positions (excluding elected officials).

New Business #2 Sign an Agreement with GHD Consulting Services/Sanitary Sewer Consolidation

6) THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS OFFERED BY COUNCILMEMBER MAJCHRZAK, WHO MOVED ITS ADOPTION, SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER FLYNN, TO WIT:

WHEREAS, The Engineering Department has been working with GHD, Inc. to develop a scope of services and proposal to perform the Sanitary Sewer District Consolidation Study. This is the first step in creating a Town Wide Sanitary Sewer District or just combining the twenty-three individual Town Districts, and

WHEREAS, the proposal from GHD which includes data collection, asset inventory, financial O&M cost evaluation, capital investment planning, financial analysis, sewer tax and billing analysis and a final map, plan, and report. The Engineering Department will be assisting GHD throughout the process by providing relevant asset data, district maps, and other requested information. This study will also require input from the Assessor's Office, the Town Accountant, and the Sewer, Water & Lighting Department. When requested by the consultant, all information will provided through the Engineering Department as a single point of contact for the Town. GHD Inc. has extensive knowledge in this field with a professional staff capable of completing the study in a timely fashion. GHD has proposed to complete the attached scope of work for \$75,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby authorize the Deputy Supervisor to execute the agreement with GHD Consulting Services Inc., 285 Delaware Ave Suite 500, Buffalo NY, 14202 to provide services for the Sanitary Sewer District Consolidation Study for a total cost not to exceed \$75,000.00, as recommended by the Town Engineer.

The resolution was unanimously adopted.

BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

Todd Barber lives on Acorn Circle and is part owner of the Acorn Pond. He has questions regarding the pond and the Town taking some responsibility for the maintenance of the pond and the cost of the maintenance.

ELECTED OFFICIALS & DEPARTMENT MANAGERS

Deputy Supervisor Liberti recommended people who are biking and jogging to wear reflective clothing for visibility and safety.

Councilmember Majchrzak stated that with the rise in COVID 19 cases, the Town of Orchard Park and parts of Erie County are now going into the COVID 19 Orange Zone. This affects non-essential businesses to be closed, schools going 100% virtual, no indoor restaurant dining and any meetings cannot exceed 10 people. This will impact the Town Board meetings, as residents will not be able to attend, but will be able to follow the meetings virtually. Regarding the last wind storm, Councilmember Majchrzak said the Town was minimally affected. This was due to his contact with the public utilities, and their subsequent cooperation in upgrading the Town's substations and clearing out the trees that affected overhead lines in the Town. He wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving and stated there will be no work session the day before Thanksgiving.

Councilmember Flynn said today Governor Cuomo stated in his address that Erie County has the highest Corona Virus cases in the state, and Orchard Park was number 3 on the list. We are now placed in the Orange Zone with all the corresponding restrictions. It will fall to the local government offices, Police and Code Enforcement, to enforce these restrictions. He asked the residents to take on personal responsibility to follow the restrictions for their own safety and for the safety of the Government workers who have to enforce the restrictions. Councilman Flynn stated this was going to be his last in person meeting for a while, as he has a family member undergoing chemo therapy at this time. He will be attending the meetings virtually.

Police Chief Wehrfritz stated that with the leaf pickup, do not put them in the road, it is a driving hazard.

Highway Superintendent Fred Piasecki said Highway is focusing on leaf and brush pickup.

Town Engineer Bieler, regarding the Acorn pond, said the DEC would not allow the developer to fill it in as they considered it an asset for storm water run-off. As for water quality, the DEC did not see any reason that the Town could not do some treatment on the pond. That and dredging would help control the algae and weeds. The Town only owns a small portion of the pond. The dredging of Acorn Pond would be a capital project that could be discussed by the Town Board.
